Senior Standing (SS) means the student has successfully completed at least 165 ECTS units to take this course

Faculty Council decision is required to bypass a pre-requisite for any course.

This new curriculum will be applicable to students who enrol in the Freshman year from the academic year 2023-2024 and onwards.

For the existing students, the Faculty Council will make plans for the proper adaptation to the new curriculum.
