Three Free Elective courses are taken from any program in any faculty.




Two University Electives are taken from Table 1.

Two Language Elective courses are taken from the list of language courses provided (can not be the student's mother language).

In exceptional cases only, Faculty Council may make a decision for a student bypass a prerequisite for any course.

Work placement/Internship is typically practiced in summer for a period of at least 25 work days, amounting to a minimum of 150 hours.

Junior standing: students must have completed at least 108 ECTS successfully; Senior standing: students must have completed at least 168 ECTS successfully.
