1. **Assoc. Prof. Dr. Mirsad Karic**, Faculty of Business and Administration, International University of Sarajevo – appointed in the scientific field of International Relations (chairman),
2. **Assist. Prof. Dr. Joseph Joe Kaminski**, Faculty of Business and Administration, International University of Sarajevo – appointed in the scientific field of International Relations (member).
3. **Assist. Prof. Dr. Emir Suljagic**, Faculty of Business and Administration, International University of Sarajevo - appointed in the scientific field of International Relations (member).

COMMITTEE PROPOSAL

Committee evaluated application of Dr. Aliaksandr Novikau for the position of Assistant Professor in the scientific field of International Relations. After analysis of all documents submitted to the public vacancy announcement, Committee decided that application by Dr. Aliaksandr Novikau is acceptable since the candidate fulfils conditions and expectation regarding a) scientific field, b) quality of publications, c) quality of education and d) ability to teach wide range of courses from IR program curriculum, and therefore Committee proposes to Faculty Council of the Faculty of Business and Administration of the International University of Sarajevo to appoint Dr. Aliaksandr Novikau in the position of Assistant Professor in the scientific field of International Relations.

A – Biographical information and academic degree of candidate

Dr. Aliaksandr Novikau received doctoral degree in Political Science at the Northern Arizona University (USA) in 2017. Dr. Aliaksandr has been an adjunct faculty at the Northern Arizona University for the period between January and May 2018 and Graduate Teaching Assistant at the same institutions between 2011 and 2017.

During the Spring 2018 Aliaksandr was an adjunct lecturer at the Northern Arizona University and taught two courses, Global village and Comparative Politics. From the Fall 2016 until the Spring 2017 he was a graduate teaching scholar at the same institution. During this time he taught courses on Political Ideologies and Environmental Policy.

His research is in the area of Political Science with the focus on International relations, Comparative Politics and Public Policy.

He has multiple publications that have resulted from his research. 
Dr. Aliaksandr has been successfully working as adjunct faculty and graduate teaching assistant at the Northern Arizona University (USA) for more than seven years.

D. COMMITTEE PROPOSAL




