ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The sphere of interest of my research is related to the impact of the socio-political situation on illegal urbanization, ie the lack of urbanization in BiH cities, with a special emphasis on Sarajevo as the capital city where the inflow / migration of the population is the largest and ultimately with the most illegal construction. Although illegal construction in Sarajevo started before the aggression in BiH, the focus of my research is post socialist period in BiH, when a large part of the population either died or emigrated to allow new migrations. Rapid rise in the population in cities is a feature of such post-war situations, where the rural population inhabits urban centers in search of better prospects for the future. Due to the increased number of inhabitants, the demand for new housing spaces is growing, causing forced urbanization, with sometimes illegal construction that is (post)regulated with legal norms. To understand this situation, we first need to look for causes in the social and political reasons that have led to this situation. Such spontaneous and uncontrolled urbanization has many problems without taking into account the lack of aesthetic value of the buildings themselves or the lack of technical and social infrastructure. It consists of a lack of standards and safety regulations: blocking roads, inadequate load-bearing walls or adding floors to the existing structure...
